BACK TO SCHOOL TIPS FOR A SMOOTH TRANSITION

Talk about it-Start talking about preschool and some of the little things that might change in their daily routine.

Exposure - Watch a show that talks about your child's favorite character starting preschool. If your child has trouble with separation, come up with a catchy phrase such as "See you later alligator, after while crocodile" and practice at home.

Routine- Establish a morning routine to help your child be in the habit for when school starts.

Make it fun - Plan on going to orientation to meet your child's teacher and see the classroom. Celebrate this big milestone with a fun treat afterwards.



Fire Safety Week-

During Fire Safety Week we talk about what to do if there is a fire at school or at home. We may have a visit from Fire Fighters and a Fire Engine (if there is not an emergency where they are needed!) on Monday, September 8th at 10am. We will have a fire drill at school too. Talking about fires may raise some concerns and fears.

CHAPEL- Blessing of the Backpacks!

You are welcome to join us during our chapel time each month. Children are dropped off in their classrooms and parents (family and friends are invited too!) head down to the sanctuary to grab a seat. As we arrive, children may sit with their parents. Each chapel typically lasts around 20 minutes. After chapel we say goodbye to any guests that were able to join us and go back to our classroom. Each month we will send home a small offering pouch that you may send back with offering money if you wish. Our first Chapel is on Thursday, September 11th at 9:30am. There will also be a Coffee Connect before chapel for parents to grab a coffee and visit with other parents before chapel begins.



Talking With Your Child About Art

Each day we will create, examine and reflect on our art work. Each creation may be an expression of their feelings or a sensory experience where they try mixing colors with their hands (or both at the same time!) As adults, we may look at art as needing to look like something, but in our classroom, we value the process! There may be art projects that we provide where we will focus on the outcome (parent gifts for example), but the majority of our art projects will be process art! This means that the child will get to choose how much paint they use, if they will mix all the colors together, or if they want to make a few more paintings! We do ask that each child give art a try. We have found that once a child realizes that their project will be their own creation, they are much more willing to participate! When talking with your child about their creations, it is best not to judge their art or offer correction. Instead, try to comment on their effort and notice any patterns, colors, shapes or textures.. Your child's art work will be unique, empowering, child-directed, and often may be unrecognizable! As we are talking about the many ways that God has made each of us unique and special, art is a wonderful way to showcase those amazing, creative differences and celebrate each child's artistic gifts! We try to offer at least one art project per school day (and many days there will be two!) so you will be able to see many examples of your child's creativity!
