Our students love to play with playdough everyday! As they mold



Preparing for Cooler Weather and Playing Outside!

As the temperature drops we will still be going outside each day in the afternoon for full day students! For half day and full day students- we will play in the Big Room for our large muscle time each morning. As long as the "real feel" temperature is above 0 degrees, we will play outside. Please send a light jacket with your child if the weather will be chilly. They can hang up their coat on the hooks in the coat room. When snowy weather comes, we ask that each full day student bring a bag to keep their winter gear organized. A reusable, cloth shopping bag seems to work well! (We cannot use plastic grocery bags at school.) Full day students will bring a warm winter coat, boots, snowpants, hat and mittens to school each day in their bag. (Waterproof mittens are easiest to get on and will keep them the warmest!) We ask that you label all of your child's winter gear. Each year we have duplicates of the same mittens (and sometimes we even have the same coat or hat!) It makes is so much

easier to find the owner if it is labeled!
