Dear NBPC Family:

I am writing this in the midst of digging out from our first significant snowfall of winter, as each of us woke up on a Monday morning with a foot of snow on the ground!

Writing this article also marks one year I have been with you as your Transitional Pastor. I interviewed for this position on a snowy day, and I come up on one year with you on an even snowier day!

On this one year anniversary, I think it will good to share where we have been, where we are, and where we are going with the transitional process.

I began my time with you conducting over 70 SWOT interviews, asking people to identify the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats regarding New Bedford Church. This led to the formation of a SWOT analysis team, consisting of Lori Smith, Greg McMillan and Nancy Cummings. They took all my raw data and created a SWOT Analysis Report, which was reviewed and approved by Session, and then released to the congregation.

As this was going on, we had many of you fill out a Missional Posture Survey, which gauged where this congregation is at in terms of missional outreach. This resulted in a Missional Posture Survey Report, which was also reviewed by Session and released to the congregation.

With those two important data points complete, I appointed a Vision Team, an important part of the EPC transitional process. Your Vision Team members are Sam Jones, Doug Houk, Lee Harris, Debi Fynes, Erika Taylor and Cindy Bell. They also each have three to four prayer team members with which they are reviewing discussions and praying through decisions.

The Vision Team began meeting in December and are continuing in this new year, meeting every two weeks. They have read an important book in the transitional process, called "Simple Church," and in addition have read a book on one's relationship with God, called simply "With." At this point, the team is working on identifying a simple process for spiritual growth in church members. This will eventually become their recommended, vision, mission and purpose for New Bedford Church.

Once details of this are in place, the team will design preliminary action strategies based on the church vision, the SWOT Report and the Missional Posture Survey Report; they will also develop a Preliminary Pastor Profile and then will present to Session for Session edits and final approval.

In discussions with the Vision Team, this new vision for the church will then be presented to the congregation in a series of informational meetings. This will be followed by the creation of an Implementation Team, to help execute the strategies contained in the vision; and, at the same time as this, a Pastor Search Team will be formed as well.

Things are progressing in the time frame expected. As I explained to the Session when interviewing for the role, a typical transitional pastorate and transitional process takes 18 to 24 months. We are on track for that.

In the mean time, it is also a privilege to share God's word with you. Our February sermon series will focus on the New Testament book of Titus, with a sermon series called "CON-crete Living."

May God richly bless each of you in this new year.


