Dear Members and Friends of New Bedford Church,

We are in the middle of Summer but we are also in a time of planning for the Fall. I want to share with you a number of ministries that need you to be a part of.

We are very, very blessed as a church to have a good number of children in our ministries. Truthfully this is not the case in many churches. This Fall we are beginning a new ministry to children and their moms and expanding an existing ministry to children. AWANA, which meets on Wednesday evenings, is our mid-week ministry to school age children. Dawn Harris leads this ministry. Last year we expanded the ministry to include 4 and 5 years olds (Cubbies) and this year we are again expanding to include 3 year olds (Puggles). This ministry requires many volunteers. Please contact Dawn and minister to the children of our community. (see more info in this newsletter)

We are also beginning a MOPS (Mother of Pre-Schoolers) ministry in our church. Erika Taylor is beginning and leading this ministry. This will minister to both the moms and their young children. They will meet twice a month on Tuesday mornings. As you might guess, this also requires many volunteers. Please contact Erika if you are able to touch the lives of these children and their moms. (see more info in this newsletter)

Switching gears I want to let you know of some hands on mission projects that need your hands. For the past few years we have had the privilege of supporting an EPC church plant and a neighborhood ministry in the Idora neighborhood of Youngstown named Hope for Renewal. Gary Koerth, the staff person for this ministry, gave an update when he led our worship in June. Gary has just announced that Hope for Renewal has just purchased a store front on Glennwood Ave. This will serve as a meeting place and provide some transitional housing. On August 19th a workday is scheduled at this storefront. This will be a clean-up and demolition day. Later additional work times will be scheduled to do plumbing, electrical, carpentry, drywall and painting. If you are able to help on the 19th let me know.

We also have had the joy for many years of supporting Autumn Marshall and Matt and Stacey Ayers in Haiti. The Mission Committee believes it is now time to have a Mission Trip to see first-hand the work they are doing and have a hands on ministry time in Haiti. The dates and the details are coming together. We will depart Pittsburgh on Feb. 2nd (Friday). After spending one night in Port au Prince we will take a small airplane to the mission site of Autumn. We will spend 5 days (4 nights) with Autumn. We will again board the small plane and fly to the seminary where Matt and Stacey serve. Again we will spend 5 days (four nights) at Emmaus. Sunday evening the 11th we will fly from Cap Haitian, Haiti to Miami. After spending a night in Miami we will arrive back in Pittsburgh on Monday the 12th. If you are interested in the trip contact me. We will need final reservations (so we can book all 4 flights) by the end of September.

It is a joy to see the hand of the Lord at work in our midst. It is easiest to see the working of the Lord when you are part of the ministry. Plan now to be part of our ministries.



Q: Who can come to Awana? Awana is an evening program that has four clubs: Puggles-Ages 2 & 3, Cubbies-Ages 4 & 5, Sparks-Grades K-2, Truth and Training-Grades 3-6.
