Dear friends and family

Thank you for all of your prayers and financial support while I was at Miracle Mountain Ranch. During the summer, I was an assistant counselor for children ages 8 – 13. I taught them about Jesus, helped them reach the goal of becoming saved if they were not saved already, and I led multiple games!
