Dear NBEPC Family:

Usually in this space, I will take the opportunity to tell you of upcoming sermon series or to encourage you about some outstanding initiative the church has undertaken.

However, this month, in light of the sudden and shocking news of our beloved Sam Jones going to be with the Lord, I feel led to just speak from the heart with the prayer that it minister to you.

I have heard a number of you express that the church has been through a whole lot these past couple of years with the number of saints in this church who have passed on their heavenly reward. It has been a lot. Grieving is one thing, but when grief follows grief and then more grief, it can sometimes feel like it is more than the body can bear.

It is a comfort to you when you grieve; and helps provide answers to the question why.

It was through the Bible that I came to the peace of understanding that God will indeed protect us as Christians, until all the assignments He has for us are done. Then He will call us home. For some this is sooner than any of us would expect. And sometimes there is, as was the case with Sam, a suddenness with which God calls us home. Sam went to be with the Lord so quickly that I have likened it in my own mind God sending the chariot for Elijah in the Old Testament.

What I have just written is to in no way negate the sense of sorrow or loss when someone like Sam, or Jim, or Jake, or Bobbi, or Jane, or Mel, or Jason are called home. I love you so much that as your undershepherd, I feel those losses intensely with you. For days, I could not stop weeping at the suddenness of Sam's passing. But it does give us perspective, and solace. Each of those individuals I mentioned are more alive now than they have ever been.

May you keep praying, keep in His word, and keep your perspective as we journey through the highs and lows of this life together.




Join us on Wednesdays from 5-7pm as we continue our DVD study BASIC by Francis Chan.
