

Dear NBEPC Family:

Thank you all so much for the continued prayers for Connie, and the prayers for me as I underwent a prostatectomy back on October 25, four days later than planned due to an emergency surgery on someone.

I write this as I am in the process of moving slowly back into things again, working at the home office today, for example, with the anticipation of being fully back in the church office by Thursday, November 3. Many thanks to Mitch Tepper and Gordon Jardey who filled in for me in my absence. And public thanks to my 40+ year friends Bill and Mary Ellen McDowell, who spent eleven days with us to make sure Connie's care did not drop off, and so I could heal. Connie, incidentally, responded well to the dosage reduction in her new chemotherapy and so far has not suffered the horrible side effects she had with the first treatment. I ask continued prayers for her, for GayAnn Miller, for Brenda Hostettler's Uncle Louie, and for all of those battling the hideous disease of cancer.

Before my surgery and now that I am moving back, a big priority for me is filling out the Implementation and Pastor Search Teams. I contacted and received a few yeses before my surgery, and hope to complete things in the next few weeks.

In the meantime, I begin a new sermon series for November, and leading into Advent (if you can believe it!) It is called "Fearless" and it is based on Paul's second letter to Timothy. Paul was inspired to write as he neared his martyrdom, and what he shared with Timothy has relevance for you and me as we deal as Christians with trials, with a culture increasingly hostile to Christianity, and as we face possible persecution that Pastor Andrew Brunson predicted at this past summer's EPC General Assembly.

Many blessings to you and to your families as Thanksgiving draws closer. No matter what you might be dealing with in life right now, all of us can give thanks for the gift of Jesus Christ and the eternal life He offers in heaven, where there will be no more sorrow, tears, illnesses or yes, surgeries.




