



We Welcome Rev. John A. Muse to South Aiken Presbyterian

We welcome Rev. John A. Muse as SAPC's Interim Pastor. John will be leading worship this Sunday, March 18th. A reception is being planned to welcome John to SAPC for March 25th. Details about the reception will be announced as they become available.

John is a minister member of the Presbytery of Charlotte. He was educated at Union Theological Seminary in Richmond, Virginia. John was ordained in 1993 and has been serving Presbyterian Churches in the Carolina's every since ordination.

John has served the church as an installed pastor for ten years and for the past 15 years, he has served as an intentional interim minister. South Aiken will be the ninth congregation he has served as a transitional pastor. Most recently, he served the Starmount Presbyterian church in Greensboro, NC.
