Motion to approve agenda, MSP

Shawn Kang from 1001 New Worshipping Communities presented a slide show on the resources available through PC (USA) to support New Worshipping Communities.

Ministry updates

- Safe Harbor, Cambria: Susan reports assets of \$101,000. Active pulpit via zoom through June 2022 with Eugenia Gamble actively participating via Zoom. Clarification on status needed: as remnant from Cambria Pres., it feels like NCD, which precludes support from 1001 New Worshipping Communities. It could benefit from status change to NWC. Susan suggested that CDC consider allocating unused 2021 coaching funds to Safe Harbor.
- Resurrection Church NWC, Grover Beach: Ron reports continuing with the Learning Pods.
- The Way Station, NWC, Camarillo: Mickey reports efforts to expand into Oxnard; Ron and Mickey are meeting weekly with Day-by-Day Ministries to find areas of cooperation.
- Church in the Park, NWC, Santa Paula: Ron reports that the \$30k Growth Grant was approved.
- Esperanza Viva, Ron reports trying to find new leadership
- Church at the Collection: Mickey reports some progress, lots of good conversations. Sean replaces Mickey as liaison to Church at the Collection.
- Hope and Peace Park, Sean no report. Sean will follow up to determine status and viability of this ministry and report back to CDC.
- Frist Presbyterian SLO Mission Study: Lee reports they are making good progress and suggested a very broad approach in the distribution of their Mission Study Survey.
- Santa Maria Gracious Dismissal funds: Vera and Sean will meet with Bruce and Pastor Garret to discuss possibilities. There needs to be a plan in place by 2022 on the use of these funds. One suggestion is to support a free clinic in Santa Maria to serve field workers and the poor.

Revitalization \$50,000 monies:

- CDC set a Special Planning meeting for December 7th, 2021, at 3:00 to discuss ideas for creating a Process and a Plan for managing/use of these funds.

Goals for 2022:

- Seek additional new members for the team
- Select a vice chair,
