

CFC Safety Precautions

To protect the safety of our church family, we have outlined the following safety precautions for in-person gatherings. Adherence to these items is a requirement for attendance of the service.

Carolina Family Church makes the following commitments:

1. The facility will be thoroughly disinfected before and between services.
2. Hand sanitizer stations, masks, and disposable gloves will be available for those who need them.
3. All attendees will have their temperature checked as they enter the facility.
Anyone with a temperature of more than 100.4 will not be admitted.
4. Based on our State Governor's Executive Order, as it pertains to theaters and conference centers, capacity in the Auditorium will be limited to 75 (*not including staff and team members*). This is 30% of the room's stated emergency capacity of 250.
5. We will remain flexible and make any necessary adjustments in the interest of the safety of our church family. If any changes are necessary we will communicate them by email.

By registering for the event, you make the following commitments:

1. I do not have an active COVID-19 diagnosis.
2. I have not been in contact with someone with a confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis within the last 30 days, **or**, I have been in contact with someone with a confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis, but I have properly quarantined and/or received a negative test result.
3. I will wear a face-covering over both my mouth and nose at all times while inside the facility.
4. I will maintain a safe distance of 6' from anyone not in my seating group while inside the facility.
5. I will adhere to any changes the church makes to the safety precautions as we approach the service, or will cancel my registration in the event that I prefer not to.
