Four of our Stained Glass Windows in the Tower

CROSS WINDOW

The cross is in three pieces to represent the Trinity.

The background (sky) is in twelve pieces for the twelve apostles.

The ground is in one piece representing our one Faith in which the cross is rooted.



BIBLE WINDOW

The two pages represent the Old and New Testaments. The New Testament page is split by a red bookmark representing the blood of Christ that flowed for our sins.

The edge of the pages are gold representing this world's riches. The blood of Christ cuts through these riches to touch our sins represented by the black in the cover of the Bible.

The purple in the background represents the royal nature of God's Word.

CUP WINDOW

The wine in the cup represents the blood of Christ as He indicated in the Last Supper.



FISHES AND LOAF

There are two fish representing the Old and New Testament. The one fish lays over the other, as the Old Testament formed the foundation for the New. The New Testament is complete and is now our complete guide.

There is one loaf representing one Christ who is our one Bread of Life.
