




### Carols & Candles



## 100th Celebration

This information has been gathered from different articles found as we research our 100<sup>th</sup> Celebration. Please remember exact dates may not be available and are subject to human error.

The Church of God now located at 2920 West Court Street had its beginning in 1926. It was originally called the Westside Church of God and in 1942 it was renamed to West Court Street Church of God as the purchase of the current property location put us on West Court. Some Christians felt a great burden for the children in their neighborhood who were not attending Sunday School or church anywhere. A small Sunday School began meeting at 924 Tacken Street that year.

Esther and Alvis Forrester (1927-1929) opened their home at 924 Tacken Street to the neighborhood children for Sunday School. Gradually with much work and prayer this home became too small to accommodate the group, so permission was given by the Board of Education to use the schoolhouse at the corner of Barney and Mann Hall Avenue. Names like Nelson, Hunter, Weeden and O'Leary were avid workers in that old schoolhouse with the Forrester's. Pastors like Charles H. Trefry (1936-1937), Louis D. Birdsall (1929-1931), C.S. Sisler (1931-1933), Harold Grabke (1934-1936) and D.E.Nelson (1937-1938) added their strength to this work. There was not just Sunday School, but they began having Worship Services as well. This congregation first became listed in the Yearbook of the Church of God in 1931 with a membership of 15.

In 1939, a plot of ground was purchased on West Court Street and Beecher Road. A swampy plot of ground, full of frogs and mosquitoes. The area was filled and in 1940 the basement of what is now the Chapel was built. The vision of the church as this location was truly a dream.
