## ***Scripture References:***

***Proverbs 22:24-25*** Do not associate with a man given to anger; Or go with a hot-tempered man, <sup>25</sup>Or you will learn his ways And find a snare for yourself.

***II Corinthians 7:10*** The sorrow that is according to the will of God produces a repentance without regret, leading to salvation, but the sorrow of the world produces death.

***Proverbs 2:18-19a*** Her house sinks down to death. And her tracks lead to the dead; None who go to her return again.

***Proverbs 5:3-5a*** The lips of an adulteress drip honey and smoother than oil is her speech; <sup>4</sup>But in the end she is bitter as wormwood, Sharp as a two-edged sword. <sup>5</sup>Her feet go down to death.

***Proverbs 6:26-29*** An adulteress hunts for the precious life. <sup>27</sup>Can a man take fire in his bosom and his clothes not be burned? <sup>28</sup>Or can a man walk on hot coals and his feet not be scorched? <sup>29</sup>So is the one who goes in to his neighbor's wife; Whoever touches her will not go unpunished.

***Proverbs 7:23*** As a bird hastens to the snare, so he does not know that it will cost him his life.

***Proverbs 7:26*** Many are the victims she has cast down, and numerous are all her slain.

***Matthew 15:19*** For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, slanders.

***Proverbs 20:1*** Wine is a mocker, strong drink a brawler, And whoever is intoxicated by it is not wise.

***Proverbs 23:29-32*** Who has woe? Who has sorrow? Who has contentions? Who has complaining? Who has wounds without cause? Who has redness of eyes?<sup>30</sup>Those who linger long over wine, Those who go to taste mixed wine. <sup>31</sup>Do not look on the wine when it is red, When it sparkles in the cup, When it goes down smoothly; <sup>32</sup>At the last it bites like a serpent and stings like a viper.

***Genesis 4:5-8*** For Cain and for his offering He had no regard. So Cain became very angry and his countenance fell. <sup>6</sup>Then the Lord said to Cain, "Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen? <sup>7</sup>If you do well, will not your countenance be lifted up? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door; and its desire is for you, but you must master it." <sup>8</sup>Cain told Abel his brother. And it came about when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.
