### Scripture References:

**Ephesians 6:5-9** Slaves, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in the sincerity of your heart, as to Christ; <sup>6</sup>not by way of eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as slaves of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart. <sup>7</sup>With good will render service, as to the Lord, and not to men, <sup>8</sup>knowing that whatever good thing each one does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether slave or free. <sup>9</sup>And masters, do the same things to them, and give up threatening, knowing that both their Master and yours is in heaven, and there is no partiality with Him.

**Colossians 3:22-23** Slaves, in all things obey those who are your masters on earth, not with external service, as those who merely please men, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord. <sup>23</sup>Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men.

**Genesis 39:2-4** The Lord was with Joseph, so he became a successful man. And he was in the house of his master, the Egyptian. <sup>3</sup>Now his master saw that the Lord was with him and how the Lord caused all that he did to prosper in his hand. <sup>4</sup>So Joseph found favor in his sight and became his personal servant; and he made him overseer over his house, and all that he owned he put in his charge.

**I Corinthians 7:23** You were bought with a price; do not become slaves of men.

**Matthew 20:25-28** But Jesus called them to Himself and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great men exercise authority over them. <sup>26</sup>It is not this way among you, but whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant, <sup>27</sup>and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be your slave; <sup>28</sup>just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

**John 13:13-15** You call Me Teacher and Lord; and you are right, for so I am. <sup>14</sup>If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. <sup>15</sup>For I gave you an example that you also should do as I did to you.

**Colossians 4:1** Masters, grant to your slaves justice and fairness, knowing that you too have a Master in heaven.

**I Corinthians 2:3** I was with you in weakness and in fear and in much trembling.

**II Corinthians 7:15** His affection abounds all the more toward you, as he remembers the obedience of you all, how you received him with fear and trembling.

**Leviticus 19:15** You shall do no injustice in judgment; you shall not be partial to the poor nor defer to the great, but you are to judge your neighbor fairly.

**I Corinthians 3:14** If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward.

**II Corinthians 5:10** For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.
