### ***Luke 4:1-13***

Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led around by the Spirit in the wilderness <sup>2</sup>for forty days, being tempted by the devil. And He ate nothing during those days, and when they had ended, He became hungry. <sup>3</sup>And the devil said to Him, “If You are the Son of God, tell this stone to become bread.” <sup>4</sup>And Jesus answered him, “It is written, ‘Man shall not live on bread alone.’” <sup>5</sup>And he led Him up and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. <sup>6</sup>And the devil said to Him, “I will give You all this domain and its glory; for it has been handed over to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. <sup>7</sup>Therefore if You worship before me, it shall all be Yours.” <sup>8</sup>Jesus answered him, “It is written, ‘You shall worship the Lord your God and serve Him only.’” <sup>9</sup>And he led Him to Jerusalem and had Him stand on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him, “If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here; <sup>10</sup>for it is written, ‘He will command His angels concerning You to guard You,’ <sup>11</sup>and, ‘On their hands they will bear You up, so that You will not strike Your foot against a stone.’” <sup>12</sup>And Jesus answered and said to him, “It is said, ‘You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.’” <sup>13</sup>When the devil had finished every temptation, he left Him until an opportune time.

### ***1 Corinthians 15:45***

So also it is written, “The first man, Adam, became a living soul.” The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

### ***Romans 5:12***

Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned

### ***Romans 5:14 - (ESV)***

Yet death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those whose sinning was not like the transgression of Adam, who was a type of the one who was to come.

### ***Romans 5:15***

But the free gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many.

### ***Romans 5:18-19***

So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men. <sup>19</sup>For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, even so through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous.

### ***Romans 5:10***

For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

### ***Luke 5:26 (NIV)***

Everyone was amazed and gave praise to God. They were filled with awe and said, "We have seen remarkable things today."

### ***John 4:32***

He said to them, "I have food to eat that you do not know about."

### ***John 4:34***

Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me and to accomplish His work."

### ***Matthew 16:21-22***

From that time Jesus began to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised up on the third day. <sup>22</sup>Peter took Him aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, "God forbid it, Lord! This shall never happen to You."

### ***Matthew 16:23 (NIV)***

Jesus turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; you do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns."

### ***Hebrews 4:15***
