Quonset Hut

THE DREAM: Foundation, Footings and Assembly of Quonset hut. We purchased a used Quonset hut from a military academy school in Florida from an auction. Our people went down disassembled it and hauled it home last summer. We need to assemble it, put in a foundation and footing to secure it into place on the eastside of our property. It will be used to house trucks, mowers, tractor and other equipment to keep them protected from the elements and open more space in the temperature controlled warehouse. \$10,000

Containers & Concrete Project

THE DREAM: 10 containers and adding a concrete apron for the eastside of the warehouse. Midwest Mission is coordinating a donation of shipping containers. The transportation cost for each from St. Louis to us is \$1,000 each. We want to put these containers on the eastside of the warehouse just outside the loading dock to create more storage space. Currently, we are renting off-site warehouse space due to the influx in corporate donations from COVID and assisting UMCOR with mass-producing buckets. \$20,000

Semi Repair

THE DREAM: Get it Running. The semi was donated to Midwest Mission two years ago. It needs a high pressure fuel pump and some other repairs. We are using the semi now more than we could have ever imagined. With the price of shipping dramatically increasing, our semi helps us dramatically decrease cost for shipping and picking up donations and supplies. It also allows us to respond more quickly. \$10,000

2021 Brick by Brick Project Update

DREAMS COMING TO FRUITION: Thanks to your gifts to the Brick by Brick Campaign last year, we were able to make many valuable upgrades to the campus. The project schoolroom building has been many things but is now a studio apartment. This give us additional lodging for volunteers especially couples and volunteer leaders serving for longer periods. Heating was added to warehouse #2 and #3. It could not have came at a better time to be able to use all the warehouse space. With UMCOR Sager Brown still not open since March of 2020 we were able to help our partner out and produce a lot of buckets, that help keep the supply up for the entire network. The parking lot and entry drive is receiving asphalt. This will help unstable volunteers with footing, snow removal, dust in the building and hopefully help the building to pop so people don't think it is just another farm implement.
