

Cover Them With Love (sew and flip as you go)

Finished size is 42" X 60" and size of backing fabric* (No batting used)

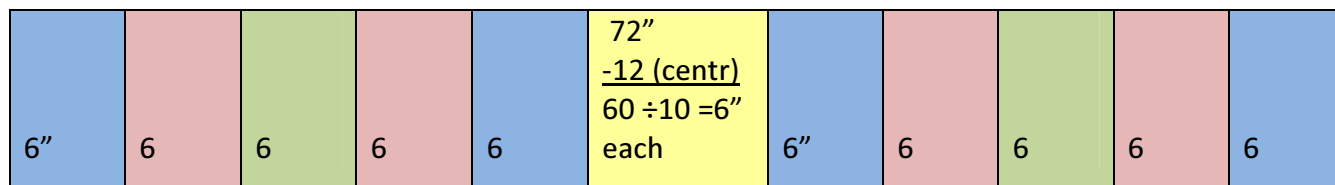
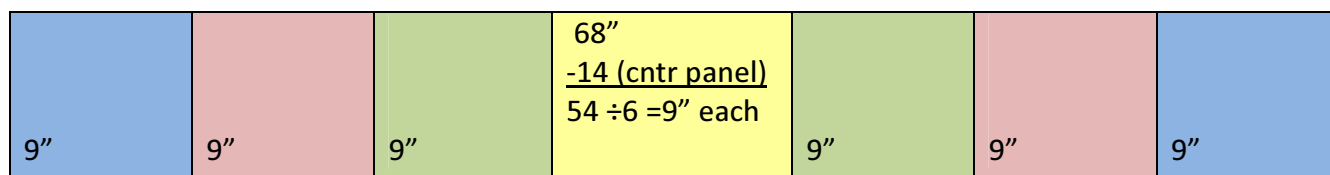
Cotton or flannel can be used for this blanket. Fabric can be cut selvage edge to selvage edge for 42" width.

Length will be 60" PLUS # of panels plus 1. (below: 7 + 1 = 8). This is for seam allowances. Odd number of panels will be used (center panel necessary). Panels can be any width based on fabric availability or pattern(s) you choose.

Solid piece of backing will be 42 X 60. *If backing is cut 1 to 1.5" larger on all sides, backing can be "wrapped" to front and used as binding, centering all panels in the middle. Separate binding will be 204" (5.66 yds), plus seam allowances

EXAMPLE for cutting: $60'' + 7 (\# \text{ of panels}) + 1'' = 68''$

(diagrams not to proper proportions)



EXAMPLE for cutting #2:

$60'' + 11'' (\# \text{ of panels}) + 1'' = 72''$

* # of panels + 1, is allowance for $\frac{1}{2}''$ seams

Place backing right side down on table, place center panel (right side up) in center of backing. Place one piece of next panel, right side down, with edges aligning even. Stitch seam, opening last panel and pressing flat. Continue on both sides of center panel until finished. Add binding
