Please take the necessary precautions if you are attending in-person:

- If you have the following symptoms: fever, cough, and difficulty breathing, please stay home and stay safe.
- Use of hand sanitizer is encouraged upon entering and leaving the church.

- Please maintain a six foot space between each other.
- All congregational members will be required to wear mask if wanting to sing along with hymns and liturgy in the church sanctuary. Band members will not be required to wear masks.
- Ushers will dismiss by rows so as to prevent any violation of State rules, please observe this.
- On Communion Sunday, we will serve on a continuing basis, please remain six feet apart. An usher will direct you as appropriate. We will use wafers and alternating cups in the tray. Those serving communion will be required to wear a face mask and gloves.
