At Sanford Sheldon, we are dedicated to the work of Health and Healing. Did you know that one in three American adults has prediabetes? Without weight loss or moderate physical activity, many people can develop type 2 diabetes within 5 years. If you have prediabetes, the **PreventT2 lifestyle change program, offered by the Sanford Sheldon Medical Center**, can help you make lasting changes to prevent type 2 diabetes. You will work in a group with a RN Health Coach and a Diabetic Educator to learn how to eat healthy, add physical activity to your life, manage stress, stay motivated, and solve problems that can get in the way of healthy changes.

The **FREE** local program through Sanford Sheldon Medical Center will be offered at the Northwest Iowa Community College in Sheldon. **The PreventT2 program will meet every Tuesday, classes starting on September 5.** Classes will meet from 5:30-6:30 p.m., with healthy snacks and water provided. The PreventT2 program will meet for a year-weekly for the first six months and then once or twice a month for the second six months. Having prediabetes means it is time for prevention!
