Peace and Rejection

Mark 6:1-13 ESV

vv 1-6

He went away from there and came to his hometown, and his disciples followed him. 2 And on the Sabbath he began to teach in the synagogue, and many who heard him were astonished, saying, “Where did this man get these things? What is the wisdom given to him? How are such mighty works done by his hands? 3 Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary and brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? And are not his sisters here with us?” And they took offense at him. 4 And Jesus said to them, “A prophet is not without honor, except in his hometown and among his relatives and in his own household.” 5 And he could do no mighty work there, except that he laid his hands on a few sick people and healed them. 6 And he marveled because of their unbelief.

2 Chronicles 36: 15-16 ESV

The LORD, the God of their fathers, sent persistently to them by his messengers, because he had compassion on his people and on his dwelling place. 16 But they kept mocking the messengers of God, despising his words and scoffing at his prophets, until the wrath of the LORD rose against his people, until there was no remedy.

And he called the twelve and began to send them out two by two, and gave them authority over the unclean spirits. 8 He charged them to take nothing for their journey except a staff—no bread, no bag, no money in their belts— 9 but to wear sandals and not put on two tunics. 10 And he said to them, “Whenever you enter a house, stay there until you depart from there. 11 And if any place will not receive you and they will not listen to you, when you leave, shake off the dust that is on your feet as a testimony against them.” 12 So they went out and proclaimed that people should repent. 13 And they cast out many demons and anointed with oil many who were sick and healed them.

GLOBAL FOCUS

Update From Bruce & Linda Cannon Providing Soul Care For SEND Missionaries (Part 2)

Bruce has been asked to be part of the team conducting care review conversations with individuals and couples serving in Japan, exploring both challenges and areas of growth in their emotional, physical, spiritual, and relational well-being. These will last through early December. Pray that God would use all these conversations to stimulate growth and healing where needed.

Bruce participated in the annual international conference on Mental Health and Missions (MHM) on November 20-23 near Dallas, Texas. About 200 people gathered around this year’s theme: **With Grace and Truth: Pathways for Humble and Effective Service/Care**. It was an opportunity to network with others who provide clinical counseling and soul care for missionaries, learn from many available workshops, and reconnect with valued colleagues who serve around the world. The conference includes time in the Word and in worship.

Granada, would you pray with me for these conversations between Bruce and those serving in Japan? Let’s also pray for continued learning and mutual encouragement between Bruce and those he met at the conference in November.
