Staying Awake

Mark 13:24-37 ESV

²⁴ “But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, ²⁵ and the stars will be falling from heaven, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. ²⁶ And then they will see the Son of Man coming in clouds with great power and glory. ²⁷ And then he will send out the angels and gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of heaven.

²⁸ “From the fig tree learn its lesson: as soon as its branch becomes tender and puts out its leaves, you know that summer is near. ²⁹ So also, when you see these things taking place, you know that he is near, at the very gates. ³⁰ Truly, I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place. ³¹ Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.

³² “But concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

³³ Be on guard, keep awake. For you do not know when the time will come. ³⁴ It is like a man going on a journey, when he leaves home and puts his servants in charge, each with his work, and commands the doorkeeper to stay awake. ³⁵ Therefore stay awake—for you do not know when the master of the house will come, in the evening, or at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or in the morning— ³⁶ lest he come suddenly and find you asleep. ³⁷ And what I say to you I say to all: Stay awake.”

1. Jesus is coming back in a BIG way. (vv. 24-27)

See also: Daniel 7:13-14; Isaiah 34:4; Joel 2:31-32; 2 Peter 3:10

2. No one knows when Jesus is coming back. So don't try to figure it out. (v. 32)

3. Every generation should stay alert. (vv. 28-31, 33-37)

Update from SAFE

(Sub-Saharan Africa Family Enrichment)

My name is Gogo (i.e. Grandma) Ida Wala, from the Simiyoni Gogo Group. I am one of the earliest gogos here, and live with my five grandchildren.



We depend on our land and farming to feed ourselves, and my heart dances with hope every time I look at my maize garden. The Mbeya compost fertilizer, a gift of knowledge from SAFE, has been a true blessing. Last season, I harvested 13 bags! Buying fertilizer is too heavy a burden, and this support has been like rain in a dry season that is saving us gogos.

Even more joyful is knowing that part of our harvest feeds the little ones in the village preschool. It warms my heart to think our work nourishes these children. When we gogos gather to pray, we lift our hands and thank God for SAFE and for the people far away who walk with us in this journey. I am truly grateful—for the harvest, for the help, and for the chance to care for our children, our grandchildren, and our community. May God continue to bless SAFE and all who support us.
