What Jesus Sees

Mark 12:38-44

Main Idea:

Jesus warns against religion that cares more about being seen than truly loving God and people.

Mark 12:38-40 (NASB)

³⁸And in His teaching He was saying: “Beware of the scribes who like to walk around in long robes, and like personal greetings in the marketplaces, ³⁹and seats of honor in the synagogues, and places of honor at banquets, ⁴⁰who devour widows’ houses, and for appearance’s sake offer long prayers. These will receive all the more condemnation.”

1) Beware of religion that wants to be seen by people.

Mark 12:41-44 (NASB)

⁴¹And Jesus sat down opposite the treasury, and began watching how the people were putting money into the treasury; and many rich people were putting in large amounts. ⁴²And a poor widow came and put in two lepta coins, which amount to a quadrans. ⁴³Calling His disciples to Him, He said to them, “Truly I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the contributors to the treasury; ⁴⁴for they all put in out of their surplus, but she, out of her poverty, put in all she owned, all she had to live on.”

2) God sees and honors wholehearted Love of Him.

3) Jesus wants to help reshape what we Love and How we live.

SCOTT AND ANDREA SWARD

Evangelical Friends Mission

For over 16 years, Scott and Andrea Sward have faithfully served in Cambodia, investing their lives in making disciples, strengthening the Church, and raising up local leaders. Through their ministry, we have seen God at work in powerful ways, including the development of a growing, indigenous movement of believers and leaders who continue to carry the gospel forward.

In recent months, due to family needs and changing circumstances, the Swards have sensed the Lord leading them to return to the United States. While this transition comes with the sadness of leaving a place and people they deeply love, it also comes with a clear sense that God is opening a new door for ministry.

In this new season, the Swards will continue their calling to cross-cultural ministry by focusing on three key areas:
