Thank you for being a good steward of the Catholic Parish of Corpus Christi.


If you spend $\$ 600 /$ month on groceries, buy $\$ 600$ each month of grocery gift cards. The church profits about $7 \%$ to pay on the mortgage; $7 \%$ of $\$ 600$ is $\$ 42$. In one year, you could be giving $\$ 42 \times 12$ months $=$ $\$ 504$ to pay the mortgage.
