

If the patient is unable to sign, a family member may do so on their behalf. Without signed consent, the in-hospital Spiritual Health Practitioner cannot contact the clergy on-call. Regardless of the new AHS protocols, patients and families may still make private arrangements for a priest/deacon to visit. # Help our parish pay off our mortgage!
