OFFERTORY ENVELOPES

***2025 Offertory Envelope Boxes**—If you haven't picked up your 2025 envelopes, and would like to continue receiving a box of envelopes each year, please contact Giselle at the parish office by October 15.

***Offertory Envelopes from Previous Years**—Please bring back to the office any unused envelopes showing dates in 2024 and older. Please do not leave your unused numbered envelopes in the pews, but instead drop them off at the reception counter.

***Using Your Assigned Numbered Envelopes**—When you register with the parish, a set of envelopes can be assigned to your family, if you so wish. When using your numbered envelopes, please note:

1. Use envelopes from the current year only, and always leave the date visible so we can see that it is from the current year.
2. It is helpful when checking our data entry to have your name on the envelope.

***Envelopes in the Pews**—When using prepared envelopes from the pew pockets:

1. Please provide the name and address we will need to issue your tax receipt. Your phone number is also helpful if any information isn't clear.
2. On the envelope that you select from the pew pocket, please ensure the envelope number is not visible. These envelopes should have been prepared properly in the parish office before being placed in the pews. If you see any in the pew pockets with the number still visible, please place them in the offertory basket, empty.

NEW ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES PROTOCOLS FOR CLERGY HOSPITAL VISITS

Due to FOIP related protocol amendments with Alberta Health Services (AHS), patients in hospital must be **registered as Catholic** and have **digitally signed consent** to receive visits from their faith community coordinated by Spiritual Health Practitioners. If the patient is unable to sign, a family member may do so on their behalf. Without signed consent, the in-hospital Spiritual Health Practitioner cannot contact the clergy on-call.

Regardless of the new AHS protocols, patients and families may still make private arrangements for a priest/deacon to visit.

Help our parish pay off our mortgage!



If you spend \$600/month on groceries, buy \$600 each month of grocery gift cards. The church profits about 7% to pay on the mortgage; 7% of \$600 is \$42. **In one year**, you could be giving \$42 x 12 months = \$504 to pay the mortgage.

If 1,000 of our parish families did the same, in one year, we would have \$504 x 1,000 = **\$504,000**
