

In Christ, God was reconciling the world to himself, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us. 2 Corinthians 5.19

ALL SOULS DAY

... a day on which the Catholic Church remembers all departed members of our family and Church, as well as those for whom there is no one to pray.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of Saints, the Forgiveness of Sins, the Resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen. This is the Faith we profess.

The Catholic Church does not abandon the departed members; but rather we follow them with prayers, and we request them to intercede / pray for us before God. The tradition of praying for the dead began in the Old Testament: 2 Maccabees 39 - 46 Why did the ancient Jews pray for the dead? For the same reason they prayed for the living: It was an act of fraternal charity. They recognized that the departed needed their help to be cleansed of their sins. And they were confident that such spiritual works would benefit those who had died, just as it would benefit someone who is still living. The first Christians, who were Jews, maintained this "excellent and noble" practice. For example, St. Paul prayed for a friend named Onesiphorus, who was apparently deceased (2 Tim 1:16-18). The Apostle also noted, without objection, that the Corinthian Christians were being "baptized for the dead" (1 Cor. 15:29). On this day, the Catholic practice is that we remember them, pray for them, (especially offering Holy Mass intentions and attending Holy Mass for them). If possible, we also visit

dead that they may be loosed from their sins" (2 Macc. 12:46).

May God in His mercy forgive all imperfections of departed members of our families and our Church: and May their souls rest in perfect peace. Amen.

NEW ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES PROTOCOLS FOR CLERGY HOSPITAL VISITS

Due to FOIP related protocol amendments with Alberta Health Services (AHS), patients in hospital must be registered as Catholic and have digitally signed consent to receive visits from their faith community coordinated by Spiritual Health Practitioners. If the patient is unable to sign, a family member may do so on their behalf. Without signed consent, the in-hospital Spiritual Health Practitioner cannot contact the clergy on-call.

Regardless of the new AHS protocols, patients and families may still make private arrangements for a priest/deacon to visit.


