A Message from our PASTOR:

BULLETIN

SIMBANG GABI is a tradition that began in the Philippines as a Novena in Preparation for Christmas Day. It typically runs from December 16 to December 24 with an early morning (usually sometime between 2:30 am and 5 am) Mass, but some communities in North America have adopted some changes with the novena starting on December 15 going until December 23 in the evenings. Though this tradition began in Philippines, this is a nice spiritual practice, which every one can follow, as immediate preparation towards Christmas.

In Corpus Christi Parish, we have Simbang Gabi (Adoration, Prayers, and Holy Mass for nine days) starting on Monday, 15th December. Adoration begins at 6pm each day (except on Sunday, 21st) followed by Holy Mass. All are most welcome to take part this novena in preparation for Christmas Day.

ONE FAMILY ONE MEAL

Secondly, I also appeal to each family to donate during this Christmas season, at least one full meal to a poor and needy, less privileged family. As we enjoy Christmas and New Year with sumptuous food, let us also look towards the poor families in our parish, in our neighbourhood, in our schools, among our friends.

Discuss in your families about this duty of ours, let your children know about it, and help others to celebrate this Christmas season in a blessed way.

You May also donate to the Vincent de Paul food bank by items, cash, or gift cards.

Let us become a blessing for the poor, needy and less privileged families.

NEW ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES PROTOCOLS FOR CLERGY HOSPITAL VISITS

Due to FOIP related protocol amendments with Alberta Health Services (AHS), patients in hospital must be registered as Catholic and have digitally signed consent to receive visits from their faith community coordinated by Spiritual Health Practitioners. If the patient is unable to sign, a family member may do so on their behalf. Without signed consent, the in-hospital Spiritual Health Practitioner cannot contact the clergy on-call.

Regardless of the new AHS protocols, patients and families may still make private arrangements for a priest/deacon to visit.

So Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house and line of David. Catholics Urged to Take Immediate Action on Bill C-9

DECEMBER 4. 2025



The Archdiocese of Edmonton is calling on Catholics across Alberta and Canada to take **immediate action** as concerns intensify over the federal government's proposed **Bill C-9 – the Combating Hate Act –** and its potential impact on religious freedom.

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) issued an open letter Dec. 4 to Prime Minister Mark Carney urging the government to halt its plan to remove the long-standing *religious-text exemption* from Canada's hate-speech laws. The letter was also sent to key federal officials. Catholic leaders warn that eliminating this protection could place legitimate religious teaching and pastoral ministry at risk.

Why This Matters:

The proposed amendment would repeal Criminal Code clause **319(3)(b)**, which currently ensures that individuals cannot be convicted of hate-speech offences for expressing, *in good faith*, opinions rooted in Scripture or religious belief.

Multiple faith communities—Christian, Jewish, Muslim, Sikh, and others—have expressed unified alarm. They caution that removing this defence could chill ordinary religious speech and create uncertainty for homilies, catechesis, pastoral counselling, marriage preparation, youth ministry, and online evangelization.

More than 6,000 Canadians have already signed petitions calling on the government to preserve the exemption.

The Archdiocese of Edmonton is urging Catholics not to wait for others to speak up. **Your action is essential.**

What You Can Do Right Now?

Contact Your Member of Parliament—Today

Tell your MP you oppose removing the religious-text exemption in Bill C-9. Share your concerns about how the amendment could affect preaching, teaching, pastoral care, and the Church's public witness.

Even a brief message makes a difference. Constituency offices track every call and email.
