About Fr Matthew...

He was born into a Baptist family in Michigan, and as a young

teen, was drawn to the Catholic faith, and felt a particular curiosity about Catholic priests. With the loving support of his mother, he received the sacrament of Baptism into the Catholic church, and was on his journey of love and great dedication. Before entering St Joseph Seminary in Edmonton, focusing on the Dominican Order, he earned his B.A. and M.A. in philosophy. He then found his way to Canada for his M.Th. at Newman Theological College. In 2012, he was ordained Canada's first deaf priest.

In 2016, when the doors to our new church first opened, Father came to our parish from St Theresa's to serve as our Associate Pastor. During his term with us, he became a professed tertiary of the Dominican Order of Preachers.

Our parish was blessed as the recipient of his many gifts, fulfilling his primary mission as a Dominican priest—the salvation of souls through preaching. From his great intellect to his sense of humour, he developed a true following of the faithful, soaking up his teachings of dogmatic theology. He left our parish in 2018 to continue his studies, writing his doctoral dissertation on the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit in the soul of Christ.

He is currently Pastor of St. Emeric Hungarian parish in Edmonton; Chaplain of St Mark's Catholic Community of the Deaf in Edmonton as well as the International Catholic Deaf Association—Canadian Section; Instructor and Chaplain at Newman Theological College; Spiritual Director of the

Catholic Renewal Service of Edmonton; and Religious Assistant for the Edmonton Fraternity of Lay Dominicans.

Thank you, Father Matthew, for sharing your time and talent with our parish this Sunday in the spirit of the archdiocesan pastoral priority—*Eucharistic Worship*.

Helping pay off our church mortgage!

If you spend \$600/month on groceries, buy \$600 each month of grocery gift cards. The church profits about 7% to pay on the mortgage; 7% of \$600 is \$42.

In one year, you could be giving \$42 x 12 months = \$504 to pay the mortgage.

If 1,000 of our parish families did the same, in one year, we would have \$504 x 1,000 = \$504,000

This benefit to the church creates no additional cost to you, our parishioners!

NEW ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES PROTOCOLS FOR CLERGY HOSPITAL VISITS

Due to FOIP related protocol amendments with Alberta Health Services (AHS), patients in hospital must be **registered as Catholic and have digitally signed consent** to receive visits from their faith community coordinated by Spiritual Health Practitioners. If the patient is unable to sign, a family member may do so on their behalf. Without signed consent, the in-hospital Spiritual Health Practitioner cannot contact the clergy on-call.

Regardless of the new AHS protocols, patients and families may still make private arrangements for a priest/deacon to visit.

UPDATE ON TEN YEAR ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS

"There is a season for everything ..." Ecclesiastes, 3: 1 – 8

As Corpus Christi is celebrating the Tenth Anniversary of its Dedication (19th March 2016 – 2026), the parish is planning to celebrate it throughout this year.

The first phase of this was to form a Ten-Year Anniversary committee. In our meeting, we decided to conduct a Census and parish registration drive, aiming to know the total strength and membership of the parish. As a result, we have begun to update the parish register.

At the end of January 2026, we have almost 900 families renewed their membership with the parish. The renewal of registration process is still ongoing. Secondly, we agreed on the need to reproduce / update the photo album directory, which Corpus Christi parish originally produced in 2017. Considering the fact that during these ten years, a lot of new families have been added to this parish as members, the committee observed the need for updating the photo album directory including the new members of the parish (if they wish). At the end of January, 140 families completed their photo shoots with Lito Soco, our parish photographer. Photo shoots will resume in April, but registration for photo shoots will continue after each weekend Mass.

We also introduced Ten Year Anniversary Souvenir (pen and T- shirts) for sale. Parishioners are cooperating rather well with the registration drive with parish census forms 2026, and all other activities.

I like to bring to the notice of the parishioners, that during this anniversary year, we will be honouring each group in the parish during Sunday Mass. Choirs, Catholic Women's League, Knights of Columbus, all Volunteers, Mass Servers, Proclaimers, Eucharistic Ministers etc. This is to acknowledge the services they all render to the parish. This parish moves forward smoothly, not because of the clergy, but because of the commitment of the parishioners, who dedicate their time, energy, expertise, other resources for the glory of God, and for the good of the parish church.

As pastor, I express my appreciation and gratitude to each of you. Please inform and invite all members of your ministries to be present at the Sunday Mass, at which their group is scheduled to be recognized.

During two Sundays in March, after each Mass, we will show videos of the church land, fundraising activities, construction etc. to refresh our minds, how God led us through, and brought us to this 10th year. It is an opportunity to look back and see where we began, and how far we have come to get to where we are today. All are welcome to watch those short videos.

TEN-YEAR ANNIVERSARY DEDICATION MASS.—THURSDAY MARCH 19, AT 7PM

We have informed and invited all those priests, who offered pastoral ministry for our parish and parishioners. We have invited also all priests in the Deanery. The main celebrant is Rev. Fr. Martin Carroll, who was our pastor at St. Teresa Parish and who planned to have another Catholic Church in Mill Woods area and arranged the land for Corpus Christi. We also invited Rev. Fr. Jim Corrigan, who led the construction process, fund raising activities, etc., as pastor of St. Teresa Parish From August 2008 to July 2017, to deliver the Homily.

We will have the unveiling of the anniversary plaque, and a reception in the hall with wine, cheese, coffee, cookies, etc.; a time to introduce all of the pastors, and enjoy some fellowship time while watching videos and photos of the different stages of development of this church—a special time for the pioneers to refresh your minds with memories and excitement; and for others, an opportunity to know where we started and to thank God for bringing us so far.

Let us celebrate the goodness of God towards us and our families through The Catholic Parish of Corpus Christi.




