NEW ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES PROTOCOLS FOR CLERGY HOSPITAL VISITS

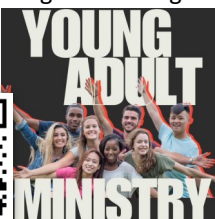
Due to FOIP related protocol amendments with Alberta Health Services (AHS), patients in hospital must be **registered as Catholic and have digitally signed consent** to receive visits from their faith community coordinated by Spiritual Health Practitioners. If the patient is unable to sign, a family member may do so on their behalf. Without signed consent, the in-hospital Spiritual Health Practitioner cannot contact the clergy on-call.

Regardless of the new AHS protocols, patients and families may still make private arrangements for a priest/deacon to visit.

Helping to pay off our church mortgage!



If you spend \$600/month on groceries, buy \$600 each month of grocery gift cards. The church profits about 7% to pay on the mortgage; 7% of \$600 is \$42.

In one year, you could be giving \$42 x 12 months = \$504 to pay the mortgage.

If 1,000 of our parish families did the same, in one year, we would have \$504 x 1,000 = \$504,000

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

The three readings today talk about God's abundant and faithful provision for His people, a provision that outlasts human scarcity and opposition. Each reading, in its own particular way, invites the believer to set aside anxiety and self-reliance, and to trust instead in a divine generosity that cannot be exhausted.

In the First reading, prophet Isaiah invites the people to come to the waters and receive nourishment freely without cost, emphasising God's generous offer of the life of grace cannot be bought.

Saint Paul assures the Romans that nothing can separate believers from the love of Christ, not even suffering or death. The daily happenings in our lives should make us closer to Christ.

The Gospel shows Jesus multiplying loaves to satisfy a hungry multitude, demonstrating that divine generosity overcomes human insufficiency.

Together, these passages help us to see that the gifts of God are not commodities to be earned but blessings to be received.

When we bring our modest resources towards Christ, he multiplies them beyond our expectations.

The same God who invited Israel towards the waters invites us today to come, to listen, and to receive life. His love is unshakeable, his provision is abundant, and his covenant endures for ever.

Let us respond with faith, trust, and gratitude, bringing our needs to the Lord who satisfies every hunger. May we, like the crowd on the hillside, learn to depend not on what we possess but on the one who provides.

God continue to bless us, bless our families, bless our children. God bless our parish. Amen.

The St. Carlo Acutis Shrine & Center for Eucharistic Encounter in Malvern, Pennsylvania, launches a new mobile app inspired by the young Italian St. Carlo Acutis.

NEW MOBILE APP DEDICATED TO EUCHARISTIC MIRACLES & ST. CARLO

On February 14, 2026, the St. Carlo Acutis [Shrine & Center](#) for Eucharistic Encounter in Malvern, Pennsylvania, launched a [new mobile app](#) dedicated to Eucharistic miracles and inspired by the young Italian saint.

"Carlo used the technology of his time to bring people closer to Jesus in the Eucharist," said Mary Bea Damico, Executive Director of The Saint Carlo Acutis Shrine at Malvern Retreat House.

"With this app, we are carrying that mission forward, using modern technology to proclaim the Eucharist is the living heart of Jesus. The app also shares the beautiful journey of St. Carlo's life, and invites everyone to advance in their own journey to become the saints they were created to be."

Developed in collaboration with Antonia Acutis, St. Carlo Acutis' mother, the app brings together mobile-ready documented stories of the Eucharistic miracles chronicled by the young saint in his [Eucharistic Miracles of the World International Exhibition](#).

St. Carlo Acutis, who died in 2006 at the age of 15 and was canonized in September 2025, used technology to catalog and promote Eucharistic miracles that had been investigated and approved by the Church. Long before the advent of mobile technology and social media, he recognized the internet as a powerful tool for evangelization.

The app also has other features such as "Live Like Carlo," an interactive journey through the defining moments of his life, or a dedicated space for online Eucharistic Adoration from chapels around the world.

A TOOL TO REACH YOUNG PEOPLE EVERYWHERE

"Carlo loved using technology to speak about Jesus and especially about the Eucharist. It brings me joy to see his devotion shared in a way that can reach young people and families everywhere," Ms. Acutis said in regard to the initiative.

"It is very important that we continue to spread the news of the Eucharistic Miracles all around the world. The App will be a great tool in continuing this mission," she said.

The Archbishop of Philadelphia, Nelson J. Perez, defined the app as

"fantastic" and highlighted how connecting and serving the youth is one of his top priorities.

"The St. Carlo Acutis Shrine and this app will help our priests, teachers and parents when talking with our children about our Catholic faith. It supports our call to action, to live your faith every day," he said.
