## FROM OUR PASTOR...

The first reading, from the book of Isaiah, invites foreigners who attach themselves to the Lord into the community of God's people, promising that God's house will be a house of prayer for all nations. God's salvation is universal, extending beyond ethnic and religious boundaries to embrace all who approach him with faith. God, through prophet Isaiah, invites each and everyone, into God's house of prayer.

The second reading, from Paul's letter to the Romans, affirms that God's gifts and calling are irrevocable, and that both Jews and Gentiles stand in need of divine mercy.

The Gospel, from Matthew, presents the encounter between Jesus and the Canaanite woman, whose persistent faith draws from Christ both a commendation and the healing of her daughter. The Canaanite woman demonstrates that persistent faith, rooted in humility and perseverance, and deep conviction can cross every boundary.

These readings challenge us to examine our own attitudes towards others, to recognise that we are all recipients of mercy, and to trust that God's compassion is abundant enough for everyone who calls upon his name. Let us therefore welcome all who seek the Lord, knowing that God's house is truly a house of prayer for all peoples. God's universal salvation, extending beyond ethnic boundaries to embrace all who approach him with faith and fidelity.

## SUNDAY CATECHISM AND LITURGY OF THE WORD

Parish resumes Sunday Catechism on 13th September 2026, with the 9:30 Mass and Liturgy of the Word on Saturday 4:30 Mass (for children of nursery, Kindergarten, grade one, grade two) in September after summer holidays.

We request and encourage parents to make use of the opportunity provided by this parish, to form our children in faith. Please register your children for Sunday Catechism and Liturgy of the Word with the leaders and teachers.

## HELP NEEDED

The leaders of these programs, need more helping hands. I encourage our parishioners who have received sacraments in the Catholic Church, according to their state of life, to come forward to support this need.

I take this opportunity to express my gratitude towards all those leaders of this program and teachers, who plan regularly and guide the program. God bless you all.

## CHILDREN DURING MASS

I notice some children bringing big toys to the church and some watching or playing on smart phones during the Mass. Some are eating in church. Parents, please educate the children to leave their toys in the car, avoid use of phones and avoid eating in the church.

My question to them is when your children go to school, do they carry those toys to the classrooms? Parents, please impart to your children from their younger days, the meaning and benefits of prayer, the church, sacraments, and different liturgical gatherings in the church. Teach them the liturgical etiquette; avoid eating and drinking in the church. Enter the church and Nave with proper disposition, so that we avoid going out from the Nave during Holy Mass.

Let us gather together, worship together, pray together and serve together. Everything else will be given to us, to our families, to our parish. Jesus told his disciples, "Seek first His Kingdom and His Righteousness, and everything else will be given to you as well" (Mt. 6.33). Amen.

## NEW ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES PROTOCOLS FOR CLERGY HOSPITAL VISITS

Due to FOIP related protocol amendments with Alberta Health Services (AHS), patients in hospital must be **registered as Catholic and have digitally signed consent** to receive visits from their faith community coordinated by Spiritual Health Practitioners. If the patient is unable to sign, a family member may do so on their behalf. Without signed consent, the in-hospital Spiritual Health Practitioner cannot contact the clergy on-call.

Regardless of the new AHS protocols, patients and families may still make private arrangements for a priest/deacon to visit.

## Helping to pay off our church mortgage!
