

What is a Parish Census?

A parish census is a survey done every 3 to 5 years to gather or update information on parishioners and other Catholics who live in the geographic area served by the parish. This information is used by the parish and Archdiocese of Edmonton to identify trends, allocate resources, and guide pastoral planning. By filling out the census, you're not just checking a box; you're helping shape the future of our parish and archdiocese!

I'm already registered. Do I need to participate?

Even if you are already a registered parishioner, we need you to participate in the census. This will help to ensure our records are up to date, and that we have consistent information on all of our parishioners.

I'm a young adult (18+), but I live at home. Should I register?

Yes! This is a great time to make your own commitment to your parish and to prepare for the many changes that are likely to come in the years ahead, e.g. moving out, getting married, having children, etc.

I only attend Mass a few times a year. Should I register?

Yes! Your registration will help us understand the whole Catholic community served by our parish, even if you are not currently registered or actively involved in parish life.
