One (1) annual scholarship of \$500.

This scholarship is awarded for academic and/or other merit-based achievements. The most important criteria is evidence of practicing your faith in your everyday life.

Applicants must be practicing, baptized female Catholics from families registered for at least one (1) year at Corpus Christi's Parish in Edmonton AB.

Applicants must be accepted into a Post-Secondary Program, under age 30, and in any year of their program.

Applications must be received by June 30, 2026.

Corpus Christi Catholic Women's League Scholarship Evaluation/Guidelines

1. *These are the guidelines for scholarship applicants (in paper or electronic form):*
 - a. *Proof of baptism,*
 - b. *Practicing Catholic from family registered for at least one (1) year at Corpus Christi Parish,*
 - c. *Accepted into a Post-Secondary Program,*
 - d. *Female under the age of 30, and*
 - e. *Letter of Reference included from priest, school chaplain, religion teacher or school counsellor.*
2. *Essay or short video/other media illustrating that the applicant is practicing their faith through everyday life, service to others within their community, and/or volunteer work. Please complete either one (1) of the assignments below:*
 - a. *Essay (between 500 – 750 words) – proper spelling, grammar, capitalization, and punctuation. The first paragraph shall give some indication of what is to follow. Preceding paragraphs shall indicate how their thought process flows effectively throughout. Closing paragraph shall indicate a brief summary of what they and/or others have gained or learned from their faith experience OR*
 - b. *Short Video/Other Media (2-3 minute duration) – communicate clearly and project their voice. Connect with their audience through facial expression and eye contact. Present their information in a logical format. Summarize with a brief synopsis of what they and/or others have gained or learned from their faith experience.*
3. *Should the applicant withdraw from the program for any reason, any monies received shall be repaid to Corpus Christi CWL.*
4. *In conclusion, members of the Catholic Women's League hope that by applying for this scholarship, applicants gain a better understanding of how their faith affects them and others around them.*
