

Frank Iritani Human Relations Scholarship, 2025 Info & Application

The Frank Iritani Human Relations Scholarship of Centennial United Methodist Church (UMC) offers scholarships in the amount of \$1000 to assist students with the expenses of college (room & board, books, food, transportation, etc.) or any educational program after high school.

The Frank Iritani Human Relations Scholarship was established in memory of Frank M. Iritani who was a member of Centennial United Methodist Church (UMC). A social service worker and community volunteer and activist, Frank cared deeply about social justice, promoting peace and improved human relations, and alleviating human suffering. The Scholarship is given annually to students affiliated with Centennial United Methodist Church who are enrolled or intend to enroll in college (2 or 4 year), trade schools or other education beyond high school.

AVAILABILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS

Scholarship funds are available, for any of the following persons:

- High school seniors graduating between January 1 and June 30 of the 24-25 academic year.
- High school graduates who are enrolled or intend to enroll in education beyond high school,
- **Students of any age** continuing or returning to continue their education beyond high school.

The scholarship is to be used at any accredited college or university, community college, or trade/technical school. Recipients must be a Centennial UMC member or regular attendee or a relative of a Centennial UMC member or regular attendee. Multiple scholarships will be awarded each year.

This is a **renewable** scholarship. Students may apply for and receive a scholarship award for additional years in school or training. For example, you may receive an award for your freshman, sophomore, junior and senior years of college or for 2 years or more of a vocational program. You must apply for this scholarship each year and be enrolled.

APPLICATION AND DUE DATE

The completed application package will include:

- a. The completed application form
- b. Your written responses to 2 short answer and 1 essay question.

The complete application package must be emailed, mailed or delivered to the Centennial UMC office by **2PM, August 22, 2025.**



4. Essay Question: On a separate page, write an essay answering the question below. (Do not exceed one page double-spaced using 12 point Times New Roman font.)

Describe one or more school or community service-related activities in which you have participated, or would like to participate in, and explain what you have learned (or would hope to learn) from the experience(s).
