- **H** – Pray for receptive HEARTS (**Luke 8:5, 12**)
- **E** – Pray their spiritual EYES and EARS would be opened (**2 Corinthians 4:3–4; Matthew 13:15**)
- **A** – Pray for God's ATTITUDE toward sin to convict them (**2 Timothy 2:25–26; John 16:18**)
- **R** – Pray they would be RELEASED to believe (**2 Corinthians 10:3–4**)
- **T** – Pray for a TRANSFORMED life after salvation (**Romans 12:1–2**)



## MORNING WORSHIP

### Standing Firm on Slippery Ground – **Philippians 1:21-30**

We honor Jesus in all things by caring more about His glory than living for yourself.

Paul does this by representing Christ boldly by:

- Making his public goal of living for Christ. This is not something he keeps private. He is **rejoicing** in Jesus.
- He recognized that he hasn't yet achieved the goal of always living for Christ. Paul knew that he needed God's grace to represent him. He is **relying** on Jesus.
- Paul knew that boldness comes from being empowered by the Spirit. This is Paul's unstoppable mentality. He is **representing** Jesus.

Paul presents a "win-win" situation for himself:

1. Paul says, "Kill me. I'll be with Christ."
2. Paul says, "Let me live. I'll live for Christ."

The word "depart" in **v. 23** in Greek is used as a nautical term to describe a ship setting loose its mooring. Death is not the enemy of the Christian. Death is similar to a boat; it takes you to your next place.

- Paul wanted to visit with the Philippians again - he longed to make them more like Jesus. He understood that ministering had a purpose for others to glorify Jesus.

- Paul knew there was only one way to live - living for anything else was slippery ground - chapter 1 in his letter builds an unshakable foundation as a "citizen of heaven." **v. 27**

- Paul was a religious man who met Christ. Everything was inferior to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ. **Phil. 3:8**

Takeaway - There is a joy in the Lord for standing firm for Christ. It is the highest way to honor God.
