

MORNING WORSHIP

Working Out Your Own Salvation – **Philippians 2:12-18**

If we're saved by God's grace, why are we told to "Work out our salvation?"

Working out your salvation means to follow the example of Christ. Jesus has given us the pattern of obedience.

We work out our salvation by going to the very source of our salvation, the Word of God.

Takeaway - We don't work for our salvation; rather we're to work out our salvation.

The phrase "with fear and trembling" **v. 12** means with reverence and humility.

What is a drink offering?

And his labor for their joy and faith is the drink offering on the side. He's being poured out so that they can be offered up. And so, he's willing to be poured out, all the way to the bottom, that is, to death.

The first recorded occurrence of a drink offering was that given by Jacob in **Genesis 35:14-15**, right after God changed his name to Israel.

We are warned about "grumbling and arguing" **v. 14** - this is an ongoing temptation for believers. The Philippian church had internal strife and external pressure. Complaining is the common language of our culture. A victim's mentality is rooted in grumbling.

- The problem with complaining is that it removes God from our problems. It starts with whispers and rises to vocal arguments.
- When we lost sight of Christ, we can go down the dark hole of murmuring. The Israelites complained in the desert when they lost sight of God's redemption and Christians will complain when we lose sight of God's redemptive work through Christ.
