### Praying for People to Be Saved - Matthew 9:35-38

We're to pray specifically for the salvation of others. Don't just pray "Lord, save the lost." Call the names of people you know who need Christ. In your prayer journal, make a Most Wanted List and to pray from the HEART:

- H** – Pray for receptive HEARTS (Luke 8:5, 12)
- E** – Pray their spiritual EYES and EARS would be opened (2 Corinthians 4:3-4; Matthew 13:15)
- A** – Pray for God's ATTITUDE toward sin to convict them (2 Timothy 2:25-26; John 16:18)
- R** – Pray they would be RELEASED to believe (2 Corinthians 10:3-4)
- T** – Pray for a TRANSFORMED life after salvation (Romans 12:1-2)

## MORNING WORSHIP

### Having the Attitude of Christ – **Philippians 2:1-11**

Believers must always guard their attitudes towards others - unguarded attitudes lead to division.

Paul offers the church four reminders of how we're to live:

- He reminds us there is encouragement in Christ.
- He reminds us of the assurance of God's love.
- He reminds us of the ongoing presence of the Holy Spirit.
- He reminds us to share in Christ's affection.

Humility is how we serve others. A humble person thinks of others. An arrogant person thinks only of himself.

Bible theologian John Stott says, "At every stage of our Christian development and in every sphere of our Christian discipleship, pride is the greatest enemy and humility our greatest friend."

How do we grow in the discipline of humility:

1. We grow in humility by **focusing on the cross of Christ**.
2. We grow in humility by **thinking of the glory of Christ**.
3. We grow in humility by **reading God's Word**.
4. We grow in humility by **our prayer life**.
5. We grow in humility by **servng others**.

Christ is our example, He humbly lived a life that honored His Father. This is amidst a culture to get and get more.

**Phil. 2:6-11** is likely one of the earliest Christian hymns that remind us of the pattern and power we have to possess Christ.

**Takeaway** - In response to Christ's universal lordship, everyone will bow and confess His lordship. The phrase, "Jesus is Lord" is likely the earliest Christian confession. **Romans 10:9**
