



MORNING WORSHIP

Becoming a Person Who Knows God Philippians 3:1-11

Meta is the number one disciple-maker in the church. Alphabet is in second place.

A Christian's goal in life is to know God. Paul proclaimed in **Philippians 3:8** NKJV, "I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord."

Every believer should be a "nothing changes believer" - meaning the fact that they know God hasn't changed amidst everything around them is constantly changing.

Paul believed it was most important to remind the Philippian church how important it is to know God. We know God by knowing the Gospel - which is Christ.

How do you know if you're a genuine Christian? Paul describes that those who do not know God as, "dogs." **v. 2** - during Paul's time this would have been a people called the "Judaizers." They believed that Gentiles had to become Jews before becoming Christians. This involved circumcision and following the Old Testament Law of Moses.

Paul is writing in this chapter that knowing God comes apart from works of the law.

Marks of a believer who knows God: **vv. 3-6**

- We worship and serve the Lord through His Holy Spirit.
- We boast in Christ Jesus.
- We put no confidence in the flesh.

Knowing God means you've been justified. Justification means just as if you've never sinned and just as if you've always obeyed. We haven't gone from negative to neutral - we've gone from negative to positive.
