### ✿ Using a Shamrock to Teach the Trinity ✿

**Matthew 3:13-17; 28:16-20**

On March 17, 461 AD one of Christianity's greatest missionaries passed away. St. Patrick's life is filled with legends. One is he chased all the snakes in Ireland into the sea; this is why Ireland doesn't have snakes today. Another legend is Patrick used a shamrock to teach the Irish about the Trinity.

Each leaf of the shamrock represents a Person, while the single stem and leaf structure symbolizes God's inseparable unity as one God revealed in three distinct Persons.

The shamrock is an example of the oneness of God - God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

## MORNING WORSHIP

### Presenting Yourself Before God Philippians 4:2-9

Euodia and Syntyche are urged to agree in the Lord.

Nothing is known about these two ladies' disagreement. They both have contented for the Gospel with Paul; their names are written in the book of life. **v. 3**

Paul offers a solution to the problem. They're to resolve the matter by having the same mind. **v. 2**

What does it mean to "agree in the Lord?"

- We have the same attitude of Jesus.
- When we submit to the Lord, we agree in the Lord.
- You move forward in the Lord, even if you don't agree on everything.
- After you "agree in the Lord" you no longer talk about your position, you've moved on and practiced reconciliation.
- Do not keep bringing up the disagreement.

When two Christians have an ongoing disagreement about something, the solution is to "agree in the Lord."

This can also be stated, "We agree to disagree."

- We're instructed not to worry about anything - worry is when we have a desire for something, accompanied by a fear of the consequences of not receiving what we value.
- Worry involves loss. It's as if you're carrying a weight that redirects your thinking away from the Lord.
- We receive God's peace through our prayer life. It guards our hearts and minds from worry.

**Takeaway:** We remove barriers in order to allow us to present ourselves before the Lord. Barriers such as reconcillaiton and worry.
