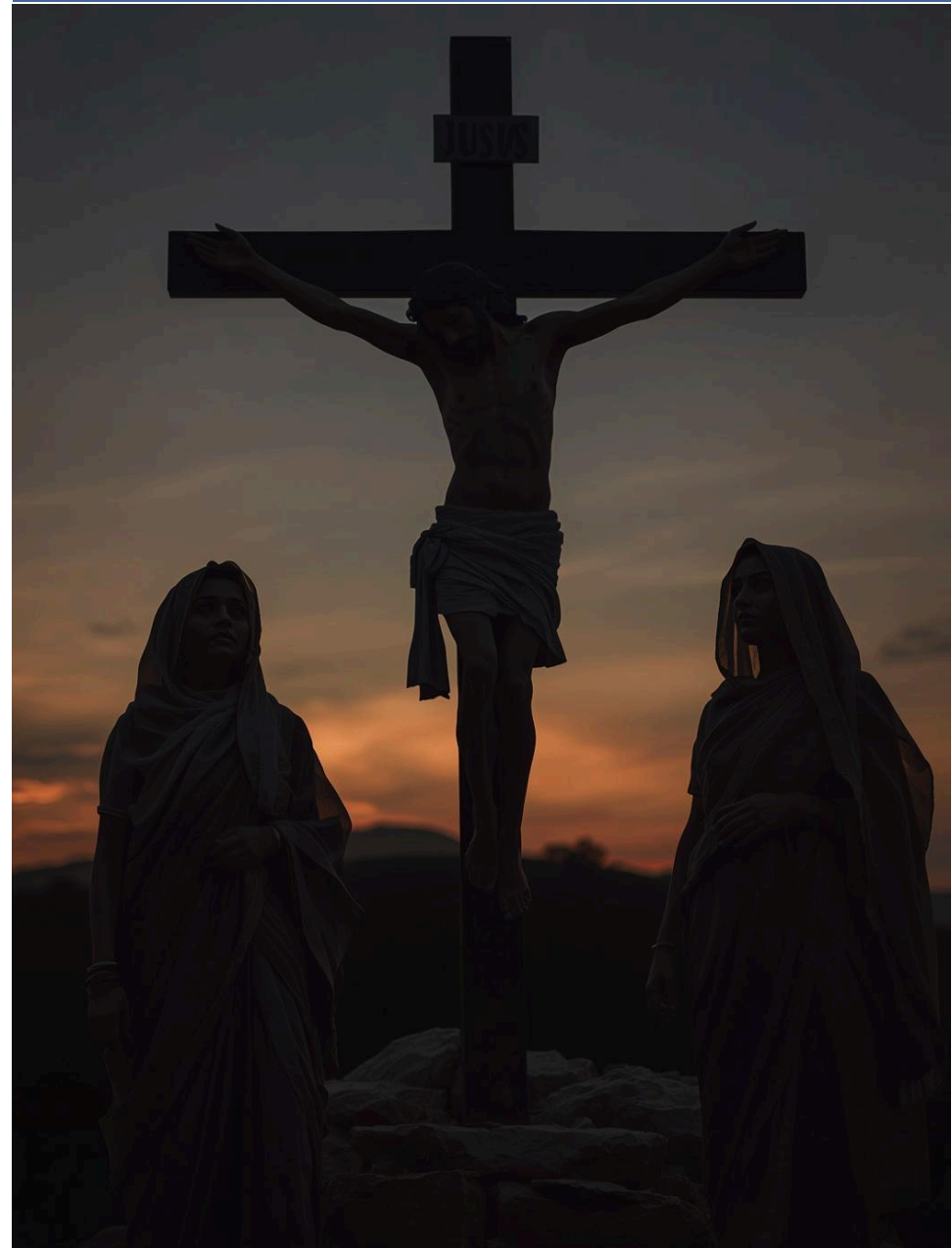

MORNING WORSHIP

The Significance of Golgotha

John 19:17-30

Golgotha is an Aramaic word referring to a hill outside of Jerusalem - it was the site of executions. We don't know why it's called "Place of the Skull" - most likely because of death.

In Latin, the place is known as "Calvary."

Jews and Romans alike considered those executed by crucifixion to be cursed.

The original sin and its resulting curse are associated with a tree, and so it is no coincidence that God's plan for redeeming us from sin and curse also involves a tree.

Christ became a curse, not because of the cross, but because God "made Him to be sin" for our sake (**2 Corinthians 5:21**).

Because of sin, mankind was placed under a trifold curse:

- 1). Separation from God (spiritual death)
- 2). Physical Death
- 3). Pain in Labor

Sinless Christ was made (created before creation) to be sin. Since Christ had no sin of His own, the only place from which sin could have originated was man.

Christ assumed the sinner's identity - He became the Christian's sin substitute.

When someone is saved - there are **two substitutions that occur** - the charging of the believer's sin to Christ results in God's forgiveness. Second, the crediting of Christ's righteousness to the believer results in the believer's justification.
