America, Iran & Israel and the Coming Tribulation Ezekiel 38-39; Zechariah 12-14

Iran (Persia) plays a role leading up to the End Times / Tribulation in **Ezekiel 38:5** as a friend of Gog (Russia, Europe or Turkey - a northern country) who wages war against Israel. We should be looking for the world to turn against or be neutral towards Israel.

Ezekiel 38-39 is unfulfilled Scripture that is likely preparing to be next. This is pre-tribulation Scripture about a coming war against Israel. Most of the book of Revelation is during the Tribulation, we're not there yet.

Sadly, America will not be Israel's friend in the future. **Zechariah 12:2, 14:2** We might not attack Israel, we could be neutral when they're attacked; we will not come to their aid. This is also unfulfilled Scripture. This could be next. **Ezekiel 38:14-16**

We are encouraged to pursue Christian maturity with three things:

We should make every effort to know Christ and know Him more intimately. Our culture has us setting our mind and goals on earthly things.

Believers should be provoked to Christian maturity - you shouldn't feel condemned if you're a Christian, but you should feel convicted.

We're free from judgment (**Romans 8:1**), but we do receive the conviction of the Holy Spirit (**1 Thessalonians 1:5**)

When God convicts us, it's evidence of His love for us. It's proof that He will bring our salvation to completion (**Philippians 1:6**).

Here are five challenges to growing in Maturity:

1. Acknowledge that you haven't arrived spiritually.
2. Always pursue a greater knowledge of Christ.
3. Never forget the greatness of God.
4. Follow examples of those who live for Christ.
5. We live in light of citizens of heaven.

We should never underestimate the power of making one spiritual change - worship attendance, prayer life or reading the Bible.

Takeaway: You can look at your attitude, desire, and Gospel passion to look at areas of Christian maturity.
