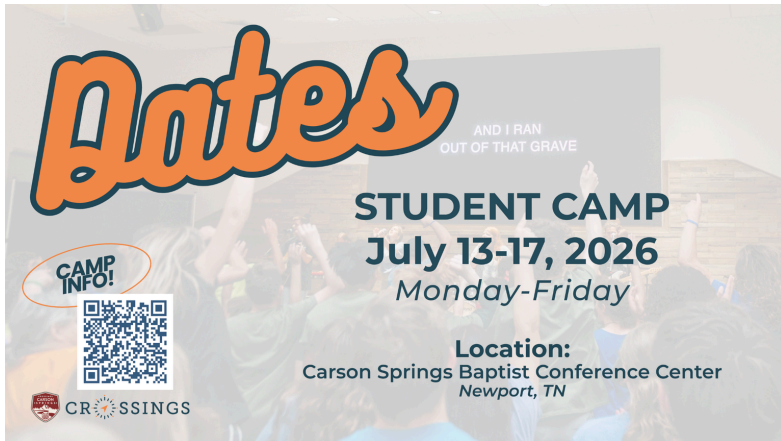

MORNING WORSHIP

Matthew 21:12-22 - **Spiritual Deadness**

The location that Jesus drove those buying and selling out was in the Court of the Gentiles. It was the area set-aside for non-Jews to worship. The Jews had disregard for Gentiles, so they used that area to buy and sell their offerings - it was busy for Passover.

It would have been extremely noisy and disrespectful to have an animal market next to a place of worship.

This fulfilled prophesy - no merchant would remain in the house of God. **Zechariah 14:21**

The Temple was supposed to be a house of prayer, except it had become a place to rob God of worship. Today, this would look like coming to worship and playing on your phone. You're physically present, but not spiritually.

The barren fig tree was supposed to have figs during the Spring. It had leaves, which were signs of fruit, but no fruit.

Jesus is illustrating the spiritual deadness of His country. It looks religious, has a religious history - but completely lacks faith.

- Worship had become a business. **v. 12**
- The Religious leaders despised the workings of God. **v. 15**
- The entire nation was in desperate need of spiritual revival. **v. 19**
