## MORNING WORSHIP

### Matthew 23:1-36 - Seven Woes from Christ

The phrase, "seated in the chair of Moses" would be similar to a pulpit today - it's an actual chair in synagogues for teaching the Law. **v. 2**

Woes are sorrows or regret. Something unfortunate has happened or is occurring.

1. **First Woe:** You shut the Kingdom of Heaven, yet you're not going yourself. **v. 13**
2. **Second Woe:** You travel a great distance for a convert, yet the convert is worse than you. **v. 15**
3. **Third Woe:** You can swear and make oaths by some things, but not others. The Pharisees had created loopholes to get out of agreements. **vv. 16-22**
4. **Fourth Woe:** You tithe to the Lord, and then treat people awful. **vv. 23-24**
5. **Fifth Woe:** The outside of your cup is clean, but inside it's filthy. **vv. 25-26**
6. **Sixth Woe:** You're like a clean tombstone - the outside is presentable, yet inside you're full of bones. **vv. 27-28**
7. **Seventh Woe:** You build a monument to the prophets, yet you killed the prophets. **vv. 29-36**

After someone passes away, you say, "He was a good man, I'll miss him." Yet, you spent your entire life gossiping and insulting the man.

**Takeaway:** People can offer the correct answers or kind words, but their actions are what they really believe. Jesus is saying, "Practice what you preach."
