MORNING WORSHIP

Matthew 24:1-31 - The End Times Certainty

Jesus is sitting on the Mount of Olives, outside of Jerusalem - sharing about to event to come in 37 years and another event that hasn't occurred yet.

What happened in 70 AD? General Titus of Rome destroyed Jerusalem, including the Temple. This ended the way of life Judaism, all the way up until today.

Jesus is going to use the destruction of the Second Temple in 70 AD, that ended Judaism as found in Scripture as a comparison of the Second Coming, including the events leading up to His return.

The key to understanding the End-Times events is **v. 4**, "Watch out that no one deceives you." Christians should not be "shocked" at what's to come. Christ is telling us what to expect.

The disciples do not understand that Jesus is speaking of two separate events - the destruction of the temple and the end of the age.

What to be looking for:

- 1). Deception
- 2). Rumors
- 3). Natural Disasters
- 4). Persecution
- 5). Apostasy

The language of destruction will be similar to **Genesis 19:17** on the devastation of Sodom and Gomorrah - destruction will arrive so quickly, believers must waste no time.

Takeaway: God's people will increase in power, witness, and impact the world amidst persecution, uncertainty, and global hostility. We approach the End-Times with a confidence that place our hope in Christ.
