Because Christ lives in us, we don't live however we want; our identity is with Christ and we live how He does. By Christ living in us, we live to please Him.

The Greatest Statement in the New Testament **Galatians 2:11-21**

I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, Christ lives in me.

What does it mean for us in 2026 to practically identify with Paul when he says, "I have been crucified with Christ?"

Galatians 2 is about having the right relationship with God.

The "Judaizers" were teaching that Christians must follow the Old Testament Law and receive circumcision.

- Gentile Christians were coming to faith in Christ but were told they must become Jews first and then become Christians.
- Paul was against this because it undermined Christ's death and Resurrection.

Peter did not help this situation, he sided with the "Judaizers" and separated himself from the Gentiles when men visited Antioch from the Jerusalem church. Barnabas was led astray by Peter's actions.

This issue was so important, **Acts 15** is about how the Jerusalem Council had to declare that Gentile converts were not bound by Jewish ceremonial law.

The Book of Galatians connects with **Acts 15** and Paul declaring, "If righteousness comes through the law, then Christ died for nothing."
Galatians 2:21

Being crucified with Christ means we are no longer under the penalty of the Law, the penalty was paid by Christ.

Takeaway - Being crucified with Christ is a new way to live, We take encouragement in a life that pleases God.
