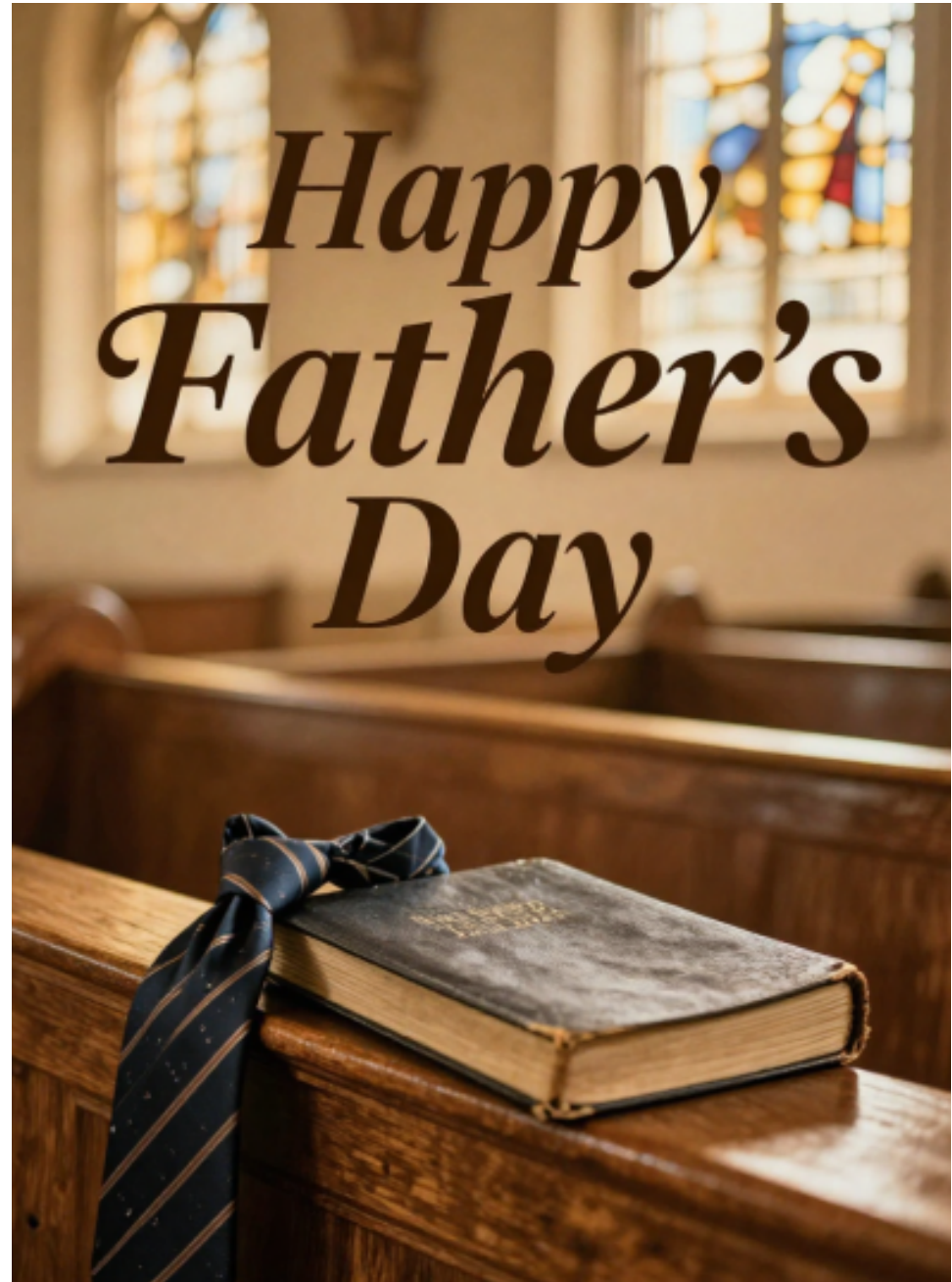

MORNING WORSHIP

3 Steps to Becoming an Encouraging Father **Colossians 3:18-25**

A **goal** of a father is to raise children who know Christ as their Savior.
A **second goal** is to raise children who are not discouraged.

The Lord is our example for Fatherhood. He is our pattern we should model. Jesus said in **Matthew 7:11**:

“If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good things to those who ask Him.”

The guide for every father should be to live in such a way that his children see what God the Father is like. Children ought to see in their human father an imperfect reflection of their Heavenly Father

3 Practical Steps to Becoming an Encouraging Father:

1. You do not have to offer your disagreeing opinion. (Not Happy)
2. You take interests in your children's interests. (Avoid Disinterest)
3. You offer hope in God. (Point them to your Heavenly Father)

When Paul says we should be fathers who give hope instead of discouragement, he means hope in God. We do not hope in money, popularity, education, marriage, or success. Fathers build up a God confidence.

When children, grandchildren or your spouse have interests that are different than yours - you engage with a greater purpose to activate those interests for God.

A good father asks himself, “How can I be like my Heavenly Father?”
