## MORNING WORSHIP

### Matthew 21:28-46 - When Religion Keeps Us From Christ

#### The Parable of the Two Sons - vv. 28-32

The father of the two sons is God.

- The first son represents sinners - tax collectors and prostitutes
- The second son represents the religious leaders.

The point Jesus is making is that sinners are the ones who obeyed God rather than the religious leaders.

The "sinners" were the ones who responded to John the Baptist's preaching on repentance.

**Takeaway:** Jesus is teaching that our actions are more important than our words. Christ calls us to repentance. The phrase "change your minds" v. 32 is what kept the religious leaders from entering the kingdom of God.

#### The Parable of the Vineyard Owner - vv. 33-46

The landowner is God - He owns the vineyard and went away with the tenant farmers in charge.

- During harvest the landowner's first two groups of servants are rejected and killed.
- The landowner then sends His Son and He's killed. Jesus is the landowner's Son - the wicked tenants are the religious leaders who are not producing fruit.

**Takeaway:** The religious leaders have kept people from hearing that He is the One promised in the Old Testament. The religious leaders were blinding the people.
