

Trying to Win God's Favor – Genesis 28:1-9

Esau and Jacob are twin brothers. Esau is older, he was entitled to his father's blessing. Their mother, Rebekah, help orchestrate Jacob to steal Esau's blessing from his father.

After Esau learned his brother stole his blessing, he begged his father three times for a blessing. **Genesis 27:34**, **36**, **38**

Esau married two Hethite women, Basemath and Judith. **Genesis 26:35** states, "They made life bitter for Isaac and Rebekah."

Hethite women are descendants of Heth, which is the son of Canaan. This means Esau married two Canaanite women. **Genesis 10:15**

- Rebekah found out Esau was plotting to kill Jacob she develops a plan to send Jacob to Laban to allow Esau to calm down.
- Esau noticed that Jacob was sent away to marry a non-Canaanite girl. Esau then goes and marries a third wife, a non-Canaanite to win his father's approval.

Esau's marriage brought a challenging situation:

- 1. He married two women his parents didn't approve of.
- 2. His brother stole his blessing, his mother helped his brother.
- 3. His father told him that he would serve his brother.
- 4. He tried to win his father's approval by marrying a third woman.

Esau is an outcast. **v. 8** says, "Esau realized that his father disapproved of the Canaanite women."

Esau was late in realizing the destruction he had brought about by marrying Canaanite wives. It was a last attempt to win the favor of his parents and God. It's like closing the barn door after the horse has run away.
