EVENING WORSHIP

How to Manage Your Money
Guaranteed Principles by Dave Ramsey
This Never Fails. **Proverbs 6:1-5**

- 1). **You must have a written budget.** List every expense, even things you wish weren't there. Post your budget on the refrigerator – everyone knows the budget. The budget is your boss. If you don't manage your money, you lose it.
- 2). **Plan your spending for less than your income.** If you don't do this, you'll never save a dime, only go in more debt. You cannot spend more than what comes in. Your greatest wealth creator is your income. Do not spend all your income away.
- 3). **Pay off your credit cards.** Do not use them again. Credit is bad, not good. Apply the snowball principle – pay off the smallest balances first and then apply the money towards the next smallest debt.
- 4). **You must have an emergency fund.** \$3,000-\$5,000 – if you don't have an emergency fund in a savings account for a rainy day – when your car breaks down, you'll be tempted to use the credit card. The emergency fund prevents you from going into debt. It's your safety net for broken washing machines, medical bills, home repairs, unplanned travel. You must contribute to this fund each month.
- 5). **Give generously.** If you budget to live below your expenses - debt free - and have an emergency fund, you can tithe and give to help others. You will have financial freedom.

MORNING WORSHIP

Exodus 2:23-3:10

When Moses was 40 years old, he killed an Egyptian in Egypt. It became known that Moses murdered a man, so he fled to the Midian, in the wilderness.

In Midian, he met his wife, Zipporah. They had a son named Gershom. Moses was a shepherd for his father-in-law Jethro.

When Moses was 80 years old, God spoke to him from a burning bush.

Moses was out of Position:

1. Raised in Egypt, a fugitive in Midian.
2. From working for Pharaoh, to working for Jethro.
3. He was on the far side of the wilderness, alone.
4. Moses saw something strange, "Why isn't the bush burning up?"
5. The voice told Moses to remove his sandals. Moses learned he was on holy ground.
6. God introduces Himself and Moses hides his face.

God gets your attention with the strange, the burning bush wasn't right.

Holy ground is when God speaks to you. You hear from God.

- God might not ask you to remove your sandals, but He will ask us to acknowledge His holiness – you're going to know you're in the presence of God.
- Moses hides his face, but in a few month, Moses will be speaking with God, face to face. **Exodus 33:11**
