EVENING WORSHIP

What is Lent? - Matthew 6:16-18; 9:14-17

Lent is on the liturgical calendar and is six weeks, excluding Sundays, from Ash Wednesday (February 14) to the Lord's Supper (March 28). This is a 40-day period for Christians of fasting and prayer.

This is leading up to Christ's death and Resurrection.

Most Baptists don't observe Lent, because it's not found nor commanded in the Bible.

- What does Lent do? It can serve as a reminder of the importance of fasting and prayer.
- Fasting and prayer are Biblical. A period of fasting and prayer should be regularly practiced in your spiritual life.

Fasting is when you deny yourself food to focus more on the Lord. The time you would have spent eating and preparing to eat, you spend in prayer.

Jesus said, "Man must not live on bread alone." Luke 4:4

There is something else out there we live on.

There are two types of fasts found in the Bible:

- 1. Normal Fast no food. Luke 4:2
- 2. Daniel Fast drink water and eat vegetables. Daniel 1:12

MORNING WORSHIP

In Between – When Your Family Wants to Go Home Numbers 10:11-13, 29-36

The Israelites are camped in the wilderness and the cloud is going to move for the first time. They are leaving Mt. Sinai.

The Israelites began to move with the Promised Land as their destination.

- God is preparing military divisions within each camp because other people groups currently lived in the Promised Land, and Israel was going to have to attack them.
- At this point of their journey, they were following the Lord's command (Numbers 9:23).

Moses' father-in-law was Jethro, also known as Reuel (Exodus 2:18; 3:1).

Hobab was the brother-in-law of Moses. It's time to move, and Hobab doesn't want to go.

- Moses needed his brother-in-law because Hobab was familiar with the wilderness. Moses is urging Hobab to serve as a guide.
- One of your greatest challenges will be to lead your family. You want to follow the Lord, head to the Promised Land; and they're not with you.

If you have a Hobab in your family:

- 1. Nothing changes, they're stuck. They want to go back home.
- 2. You can't allow a Hobab to stop you from following the Lord.
- 3. Hobab was blessed by Moses following the Lord. **Judges 1:16**

Hobab was a stuck family member who ended up serving as Moses' guide in the wilderness.

A mule today is your workhorse tomorrow.
