MORNING WORSHIP

In Between – The Spread of Negativity
Numbers 13:17-20, 26-33; 14:1-4, 26-38

God sent twelve spies, one from each tribe, to scout out the Promised Land – they spent 40 days walking around the land, taking note of everything there.

Ten of the spies spoke negatively about the land and two spies, Caleb and Joshua, spoke courageously.

- The ten negative spies led the other Israelites to rebel against the Lord. Their negative report was terrible for morale.
- The spies were on the land the patriarchs had witnessed God’s goodness. (Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob)

Four Dangers of Negativity:

1. Thinking evil or believing doubt is sinful. It distorts what God can do.
2. Negativity spills over to people who you didn’t intent for it.
3. Negativity kills another person’s reputation.
4. Negativity hinders your future.

Rather than believing God, trusting in God’s faithfulness – you believe slander, a critical comment.

James 3:14-16 tells us that bitter envy is earthly, unspiritual, and demonic.

Bitterness is a poison that cuts down others. Someone who spreading negativity is destructive. It hurts the person speaking and it hurts the one listening.

We must always guard ourselves of the two sides of negativity:

- Sharing Negativity
- Believing Negativity
